

SFCA Athletic Awards Criteria

Varsity Letters - An athlete will receive a Varsity Letter if they **start** in at least 5 games, **attend** at least 90% of the practices AND **finish** the season. An athlete will receive only one Varsity Letter in his/her tenure at SFCA. In subsequent years, if an athlete is eligible for a Varsity Letter he will receive a pin to place on that letter to represent each year the athlete has been eligible for a Varsity Letter.

Junior Varsity Letters - An athlete will receive a JV Letter if they **start** in at least 5 games, **attend** at least 90% of the practices AND **finish** the season. An athlete will receive only one JV letter in his/her tenure at SFCA. In subsequent years if an athlete is eligible for a JV letter he will receive a pin to place on that letter to represent each year an athlete has been eligible for a JV letter.

Scholar Athlete Awards - This is determined by the athlete's **Cumulative** percentages for the Year in **ALL** subjects.

Bronze Award - 92%-93%

Silver Award - 94%-95%

Gold Award - 96% and above

"SWCAC All Star Tournament Team" Pin (Varsity Volleyball, Varsity Basketball)- This is awarded to those athletes who are selected for the "SWCAC All Star Tournament Team" by a vote of the athletic directors of the league (SWCAC).

Track and Field and Elementary Basketball - Athletes in these sports will receive a participation certificate. Track and Field athletes will also receive a pin.

SWCAC Fellowship Game Certificate - This is awarded to those athletes who are selected for AND participate in the SWCAC Fellowship Game. This is decided by the coaches.

Flag Football All Star Game Participation Pin - This is awarded to those athletes who are selected for AND participate in the SWCAC Flag Football All Star Game.

Most Improved Player - This award is given to the player who is considered to have made the most improvement from the beginning of the season to the end of the season. The decision rests solely with the coaches and is only for varsity sports. Only athletes that have finished the season will be eligible for this award.

Coach's Award - This award is given to the player who has helped the coach out the most during the season. This can be on and/or off the court. The decision rests solely with the coaches and is only for varsity sports.

Most Valuable Players - (Offense and Defense) – These awards are given to the players who contribute the most to the offense or defense of the team for the season. These awards are voted on by the

coaches and the athletes and are only for varsity sports. Only athletes that have finished the season will be eligible for this award.

Christian Character Award - This is perhaps the most important award of all as it reflects the purpose of our school: to be Christ-like in all of our actions. It is not based upon popularity or athletic ability. The student who receives this award is considered to have demonstrated an active relationship with our Lord and displayed their actions on and off the court/field. The character traits considered for this award include, but are not limited to: Positive Attitude, Humility, Hard Working, Displays Self-Control, and Joyful Spirit. This award is voted on by the coaches, athletes, athletic director and staff at SFCA.
